

#### Soil

**Vegie Mix** - for raised beds, new garden beds, topping up small volumes in existing gardens. **Wicking bed mix** - perfect for self watering planters and wicking beds.

**Potting Mix** — for smaller containers, and vegie grow bags.

**Vegie Concentrate** - for adding into existing soil at a 50/50 ratio before planting, or for topping up existing beds with fresh nutrition and organic matter.

### **Amendments for Water Holding**

Sand Remedy, Cassies Clay & Charlie Charcoal will all work to permanently improve your soil's structure and water & nutrient holding ability. Dig through soil before planting.

### Seedlings

Choose healthy, seasonal vegies from our range. Heritage, non-hybrid seeds available.

#### Mulch

Light, coarse mulches are the best. Spread around established seedlings in early summer to protect soil and conserve moisture.

#### **Root Barrier**

The No.1 problem that plagues home vegie gardeners is tree and shrub root competition. We stock Geotextile and builders film barrier sold by the metre.

# Liquid Fertiliser

Liquid feed highly productive gardens with Fish Hydrolysate or Kelp fertiliser approx. every two weeks during their peak production.

This is most important with leafy greens like lettuce, spinach, silverbeet, salad greens, leafy herbs [eg basil] etc.

#### Shadecloth

White Horticultural Grade 50% or 70%, still allows light for photosynthisis but protects vegies during the height of summer.

### Minerals & Fertilisers

Blood & Bone, Multigrow Pellets, Rock Dust. Use organic, slow release fertilisers to boost soil fertility. Ask our team for advice!

### **Pest Control**
